Why Toronto?

The Toronto Region offers a significant cost advantage for Al labs:

Lower operating costs compared to major U.S. tech cities like New York City and San Francisco

Access to a large, highquality talent pool

Immigration programs

Generous R&D tax credits and government funding programs

Unlock Additional Value Through Incentives

Your company might be eligible for valuable hiring and research incentives available in our region when setting up an Al hub.

Hiring Incentives:

- + MITACS funding available to hire/work with research talent at an eligible post-secondary
- + **Co-operative Education Tax Credits** tax credit to encourage Ontario businesses to provide experiential learning and hands-on job experience to post-secondary students through co-op work placements.

Research Incentives:

- + Scientific Research & Experimental Development (SR&ED) applicable to businesses of all sizes and in all sectors to conduct R&D in Canada.
- + Ontario Innovation Tax Credit (OITC) tax credit for small- and medium-sized businesses for R&D expenditures in Ontario.
- + Ontario Research and Development Tax Credit (ORDTC) tax credit on eligible scientific research and experimental development expenditures performed in Ontario
- + Ontario Business Research Institute Tax Credit (OBRITC) tax credit for expenditures incurred in Ontario under an eligible contract with an eligible research institute (University/College).

Start Your Toronto Entity (24-48 Hours)

We recommend working with a full-service legal firm who will work on your behalf to:

- + File Articles of Incorporation
- + Secure business name & number
- + Invest Canada notification (mandatory for foreign companies)
- + Employment legislation
- + Tax advice
- + IP and trademarks

YOU CHOOSE: DIY via Ontario Business Registry (\$360 CAD) or guided legal setup with a dedicated incorporation lawyer (prices range between \$2,000 - \$4,000 CAD)
